- Shortage of latrines- needs for construction of more latrines in the CTU
- During the field visit we were notified there is storage of water and water storage
- 3 people have been hospitalized 2 children and 1 adult man with cholera in Gobweyn

REPORT OF CHOLERA OUTBREAK CAMPAIGN AWARENESS AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT FOR HAJIWEYNE IDPs CAMP

Feedback from the community,

- Lack of water storage e.g water tanks
- Insufficient of latrines
- Lack of sanitary towels
- Floods has effected most of the IDPs during this rainy season as most of them don't have NFIs or plastic sheets for protections.
- 6 people died from cholera pandemic'4 children and 2 adult men while 130 people affected by cholera
- The total population of IDPs is 580 households and 336 host communities which makes 916 HHs.
- Number of existing latrines are 19
- 3 latrines constructed by **Saado** and 16 constructed by save the children.
